




About Us

We are a charity organization based in Tijuana, working to empower the future of orphans by providing them with access to high quality education and services that enables them to grow and enjoy a full and dignified life.




Our Philosophy

Abandoned children in Mexico




Mexico has the second highest number of orphaned children in Latin America. More than 30,000 minors live in shelters or social assistance institutions, public or private, throughout the country.

Baja California ranks **second in Mexico**, only after the capital, with the highest rate of abandoned children. It is estimated that there are more than 5,000 minors in this situation in the state.





Education as a driving force for change






Intervention Strategy

Our organization has designed a holistic model whose goal is to achieve the transformation of orphanages, both in terms of infrastructure and operational management, and to implement 4 fundamental programs as well as special high-impact projects.





Our Model for Hope



Repair and Equipment Program

The orphanages that are chosen by our Evaluation and Selection Committee (ESC), are transformed through the REPAIR AND EQUIPMENT of their facilities, as well as an INSTITUTIONAL DEVELOPMENT program that improves their overall management system and compliance.

Continuous Development Program for Youth

This consists of a process of personalized support from our mentors to young adults (13 to 18 years old), in order to ensure that they successfully complete their formative stage and aim for better professional and entrepreneurial opportunities.

Development and Integral Care Program for Children

Designed for children from 0 to 12 years of age with the purpose of caring for their physical and emotional health, as well as developing strong values, capacities, and technical competencies so that they can enjoy a better quality of life and enhance their opportunities during their adulthood.

Volunteer Development Program

This program focuses on organizing and amplifying the human and professional talent of both the collaborators who provide their services within the foster homes, as well as the volunteers who actively participate in any of our programs, projects and campaigns, through training and coaching in soft and technical skills.



Telemedicine Program

To expect children and young adults to develop at high performance in all areas of their life, we need to ensure that they have access to healthcare (both preventive and corrective).

Through this program, created in collaboration with Beam Healthcare (USA), we installed state-of-the-art telemedicine equipment, facilitating remote preventive medical care, allowing general practitioners and specialists to contribute voluntarily to the care of children.





Back-2-School Campaign

Every year, our organization calls on the general public to donate backpacks, supplies, and computer equipment to facilitate the return to school.







Special Celebrations

The happiness and emotional well-being of the children is encouraged by the celebration of special dates. For this, our Foundation and its network of collaborators and volunteers organize gatherings, parties, and recreational activities with the kids.
